Wednesday, January 26 th	Words That Inspire You Students will consider words or phrases that inspire or have inspired them. K - 2 will consider words that make them happy or excited. Grades 3 - 12 will write their word or phrase (and any explanation they wish) on a white sheet of paper. Photos will be taken of students and their words in black and white to focus on the word/phrase itself. Photos will be merged into a collage for publication.
Thursday, January 27 th	Be A Good Sport and Read Day Students and Staff will be invited to wear their favorite sports attire. Athletes from various FCS sports teams will read to Elementary students in their classrooms. We will participate in 15 minutes of DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) across the campus. The poem Casey At The Bat will be read over the intercom.
Friday, January 28 th	What's Your Song? Day Students will consider the power of words in music. Some staff will quote/sing lyrics to a song that has affected them profoundly. Classroom discussions on how songs tell stories and express emotion. Students will be challenged to write a song.
