- -- District Reading Fair
- --Each day, a student selected by admin will read an excerpt from a teacher submitted favorite book/poem and the reason the piece of literature is a favorite.
- --Students making 80 or above on AR test each day can hang a STAR with that book name or another favorite book name in the library to create a galaxy.
- --Students will be able to create a piece of artwork, story, poem, etc. to display in the library at the end of the week for the "Creative Student Gallery/Exhibit". The student's ELA teacher will need to approve the artistic creation and then send it to the library for the exhibit.
- --Dress Up: Friday- "Reading Launches Your Imagination" Wear NASA shirt or astronaut (plain jeans, no leggings, no joggers)
- --Students can come to library to walk through the "Student Creative Gallery/Exhibit".
- --Let's Reach For The Stars With An All School Read Out Students will bring a towel and enjoy the last 30 minutes of class, reading outside.
- -- Extraterrestrial Visitors Community Readers will visit CES to read to students.
- -- Administrators will read book excerpts during morning announcements.
- -- Shoebox Float Parade: Shoeboxes representing favorite books will be created and paraded throughout campus by our 2nd 4th graders, led by an SHS drummer. All students will be able to view the parade.
- -- Vocabulary Parade for Kindergarten and First Grade students; choose a word, decorate a sign or poster or box, and dress up to represent the word. The parade will go throughout the campus for all to see.
- --Make bookmarks with encouraging sayings in ELA classes. (10 minute bell ringer activity). Put the bookmarks in random books in the library.
