Wednesday, January 26 <sup>th</sup>	Middle: Second author interview and video with discussion guide and book giveaway. Character Dress up Day
	High: Staff post "What I am Reading" signs outside their classroom doors
Thursday, January 27 <sup>th</sup>	Elementary: "Score with Books" Students wear their favorite team gear.
	Middle: Third author interview and video with discussion guide and book giveaway. Favorite Book and Why Graffiti Wall
	High: Read aloud- ELA teachers read the short story, "All Summer in aDay" and have an out of this world discussion.
	Million Minute Marathon (last day)
Friday, January 28 <sup>th</sup>	Elementary: "Be a Reading Rock Star" Dress up like a rock star.
	Middle: Favorite things in books partner share activity. Staff Memberread favorite picture book on morning show.
	High: "Dress the Part" dress up day. Students pick a favorite book character and dress up like that character.
