

RESEARCH MODEL

FINDS is a five-step model to help student conduct research, solve problems, or make decisions using information.



- Pinpoint your topic or problem.
- Identify information needed.
 - Make a Research Plan.



NVESTIGATE

- Apply rubric or scoring criteria to presentation.
 - Evaluate pros and cons of Presentation.
 - Revise and edit if needed.

- Evaluate sources available.
- Select best sources for the topic/problem.
 - Locate information needed.





- Select presentation format.
- Organize relevant information into presentation.
- Present information ethically (Respect intellectual property rights).



- Take notes and record data.
- Analyze information gathered.
 - Organize notes.
