K-12 Public Schools 2018-19 Highlights for Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP)

- □ Maintains required local millage tax rate at 4.308
- ☐ Highlights include:
 - □ Per FTE Funding \$7,497, a \$200 per student increase over current year
 - □ Enrollment Growth \$769.6 million increase in funds to support an additional 27,184.42 students
 - □ Safe Schools \$74.5 million, an increase of \$10 million in funding for school safety initiatives, \$250,000 minimum per school district
 - □ Student Transportation \$514.5 million, an increase of \$75.6 million



K-12 Public Schools 2018-19 Other Initiatives

- □ \$15 million to eliminate initial teacher certification and renewal certification fees this will save the aspiring teachers approximately \$555 on their initial certification and each of Florida's employed public school teachers \$75 for their certification renewal.
- □ \$12 million for English Language Learners SummerAcademies for grades 4-8
- □ \$2.0 million for College Reach Out Program
- □ \$100,000 Dr. Brian Dassler Leadership Academy
- □ \$1.2 million for Teacher of the Year
- ☐ \$8.1 million for the SEED School of Miami

Career and Adult Education 2018-19 Overview

Workforce – Total Recommendation \$487.2 million which provides:

- □ \$372.3 million in Workforce Development Funds
- □ \$6.0 million in Performance Based Incentive Funds
- □ \$67.1 million to continue Carl D. Perkins federal flow-through funds
- □ \$41.6 million to continue Adult Basic Education federal flow-through funds



Florida College System 2018-19 Overview

Total state funding of \$1.24 billion includes:

- **□ \$120** million in Performance Funding
- ☐ \$14 million in Performance Incentives for Industry Certifications



Student Financial Assistance 2018-19 Overview

- □ \$420.6 million for Florida's Bright Future Scholarships includes summer enrollment
- □ \$282 million for Other Student Financial Aid



Other Education **2018-19 Overview**

Vocational Rehabilitation - Total Funds of \$223.2 million

- □ To provide employment opportunities to approximately 65,000 Floridians in 98 field locations
- □ \$6.1 million for the Adults with Disabilities Program

Blind Services – Total Funds of \$56.9 million

- □ To provide employment opportunities to approximately 12,000 Floridians in 10 district offices
- □ \$6.8 million to provide employment opportunities for Blind vendors in food service operations
- \$23.5 million to provide rehabilitation services to individuals through the following programs:
 - Blind Babies
 - □ Children's Program (ages 5 13)
 - □ Vocational Rehabilitation (ages 14 22)
 - □ Independent Living (older blind)



Fixed Capital Outlay 2018-19 Overview

Fixed Capital Outlay includes:

- \$184.8 million for Maintenance, Repair, Renovation and Remodeling, includes
 - □ \$50 million for Public Schools
 - □ \$50 million for Charter Schools
 - □ \$36.2 million for the Florida College System
- □ \$31.4 million for Special Facility Construction Account projects
- □ \$49.2 million for Florida College System projects
- \$ 3.4 million for Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind
- □ \$ 2.4 million for Public Broadcasting
