SUBJECT: 2011-2012 Restored Continuing Resolution Funds

The Division received notification on February 15, 2012 from the U.S. Department of Education Office of Vocational and Adult Education (OVAE) that a portion of the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 funds reduced due to the Continuing Resolution passed in October, 2011, has been restored. Local education agency representatives should contact their Florida Department of Education grants administrative manager should they have any questions regarding receipt of additional funds.

On the attached document you will find the allocation chart reflecting the reinstated Continuing Resolution Funds for school districts, career and technical centers, and colleges. The funding period for these funds will be from the date we receive your amendment, in acceptable form, through June 30, 2012.

To acquire the additional funds reflected in the allocation chart (Secondary Allocation—Column F, and Postsecondary Allocation—Column G), you must submit DOE 150 and 151 Budget Amendment Forms. These funds are to be treated as basic grant funds and used to enhance a current project as well as support new initiatives provided they are reflected in your agency's approved plan.
