SUBJECT: Changes to NGCAR-PD and NGCATER

This past summer, *Just Read, Florida!* provided professional development (PD) focused on *Next Generation Content Area Reading-Professional Development* (NGCAR-PD) regionally across the state. The purpose of the NGCAR-PD Train-the-Trainer PD was to train district teams who would then be responsible for training their respective teachers in a NGCAR-PD 60-hour Face-to-Face Academy.

The "new" NGCAR-PD is 60 hours of face-to-face PD along with a 30-hour practicum (versus the 300-hour training previously required). Additionally, it is also important to note that unlike previous years, NGCAR-PD training is open to <u>all</u> CTE Teachers (not just those holding state certificates).

In the spring of 2012, CTE teachers who are currently enrolled in, or who have completed the district-offered NGCAR-PD, or who have completed previous CAR-PD and/or FOR-PD trainings will be invited to register to participate in one of 5 Regional NGCATER two-day workshops that will be offered across the state. These workshops will concentrate on the use of CTE text-related materials and the CIS model.

CTE teachers who complete the NGCAR-PD training will be eligible to offer remediation to their Level 2 students in reading intervention in their content area courses (district permitting). Additionally, CTE instructors who complete the district-offered NGCAR-PD (or previously offered CAR-PD and/or FOR-PD training) and the NGCATER training will be eligible to receive a \$250.00 stipend (with an additional \$50.00 bonus given to those participants who attended the FACTE post conference).
