SUBJECT: Electronics Engineering Technology AAS/AS Framework Update

Section 1004.92, Florida Statutes, defines the Florida Department of Education's responsibility for career education as, "The development of program standards and industry-driven benchmarks for career, adult, and community education programs, which must be updated every 3 years."

Pursuant to this statute a Program Review Committee, comprised of members from industry and education, has reviewed the Electronics Engineering Technology degree framework and recommended certain changes which will align the educational program with today's industry standards.

The attached document is the revised Electronics Engineering Technology framework with the suggested changes noted in red.
