SUBJECT: 2021-22 Perkins V Industry Recognized Postsecondary Credentials

The Division of Career and Technical Education is accepting requests for linkages of Industry Recognized Postsecondary Credentials to postsecondary Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs for Perkins V postsecondary measures for the 2021-22 reporting year.

Attached are the following two documents: ‘Preliminary Industry Recognized Credentials’ and ‘Linkage Request Form 2021-22’.

The ‘Preliminary Industry Recognized Credentials’ document contains the following tabs:

1. Preliminary List – This is a list of postsecondary Perkins linkages that were established previously, and will be carried forward for the 2021-22 reporting year.
2. Industry Recognized Credentials without Program Linkage – This is a list of potential Industry Recognized Postsecondary Credentials for which there are currently no program linkages. These certifications/licensures have DOE certification codes, and are eligible to be linked to programs.
3. 2021-22 Programs without Certification Link - This lists all 2021-22 Perkins-eligible postsecondary CTE programs that currently do not have linkages established for the Perkins V Postsecondary Measure for Industry Recognized Credentials.

The ‘Linkage Request Form 2021-22’ may be used to request new linkages of Industry Recognized Postsecondary Credentials to postsecondary programs. This document includes the following tabs:

1. Requests with DOE Codes – Use this form to request program linkages to credentials that already have DOE codes.
