
PART THREE
UPDATES TO PRIOR YEAR'S PLAN

Part Three of the Plan address whether there are any updates to the prior year's regulatory plan. §120.74(c), Fla. Stat. (2019).

- Chapter 2018-150, Laws of Florida (2018), made four (4) changes to Section 1012.795, F.S. None of these changes required rulemaking; however, the Commission determined that the Commission's Disciplinary Guidelines Rule, 6B-11.007, F.A.C., should be reviewed for consistency and any necessary changes or updates. After a public meeting was held in September, 2018, the rule was opened for development on October 3, 2018. The Commission's Rules Committee met November 8, 2018 and received public comments. The Commission's Rules Committee will meet again on September 5, 2019 and will hold another public meeting regarding potential amendments to the rule.
