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Element Name: Adult Education Entrance Profile

Definition/Domain

A five-character code to reflect the status of the adult education participant upon entrance into the program.


<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
A	Adults in Rural areas. Adult residents of places of less than 2,500 inhabitants and outside urbanized areas. An urbanized area includes a population of 50,000 or more in a city plus the adjacent areas of high density.
B	Adults in Urban areas with high rates of unemployment. Adult residents of an urban area (i.e., 50,000 or more population) which is classified as a "labor surplus area" by the U.S. Department of Labor.
C	Immigrant Adult. Adult refugees admitted or paroled into the U.S. and adult aliens not classified as nonimmigrants under the provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended.
D	Other institutionalized Adult. Adults who are patients or residents of a medical or special institution, but not in correctional facilities or classified as "homeless adults."

An individual lacking a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence as well as an individual having a primary nighttime residence that is (1) a supervised publicly or privately operated shelter designed to provide temporary living accommodations to include, but not limited to, welfare hotels, congregate shelters and transitional housing for mentally ill; (2) an institution that provides a temporary residence for individuals intended to be institutionalized; or (3) a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings. Individuals imprisoned or otherwise detained pursuant to an Act of the Congress or a state law are not, by definition, included.</p> <p>Public Assistance. An individual receiving financial assistance from federal, state and/or local programs, such as aid for dependent children, senior citizens assistance, general assistance and aid to the blind or totally disabled. Unless social security recipients are also receiving old-age assistance or other forms of public assistance, they should not be included in this category.</p> <p>Not Applicable.</p>			
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
