

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

1. **District Number, Current Enrollment must be numeric, in the range 01-70 or 72-76 and must be correct for the district submitting the data. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since the District Number, Current Enrollment is not in the appropriate range. The fourth record would be rejected if district 01 submitted the record.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the District Number, Current Enrollment and resubmit the record.

2. **School Number, Current Enrollment must be numeric in the range 0001 to 9899, or it must be N998 or N999. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The second two records would be rejected. The first of these would be rejected because the School Number, Current Enrollment is not in the appropriate numerical range. The second of these two records would be rejected because the School Number, Current Enrollment is not numeric.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Current Enrollment and resubmit the records.

3. The first nine positions of Student Number Identifier, Florida must be numeric. The tenth position of Student Number Identifier, Florida must either be an "X" or numeric. If the tenth position of Student Number Identifier, Florida is numeric, the first two digits must be a valid district number in the range 01-70 or 72-76. -record rejected-

Note: For additional information on Student Number Identifier, Florida refer to the DOE Information Data Base Requirements: Volume I -- Automated Student Information System, Appendix C, for acceptable codes.

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because when the social security number is used as the Student Number Identifier, Florida, the tenth position must be an "X". The fourth and sixth records would be rejected because the Student Number Identifier, Florida contains blanks. The fifth record would be rejected because the first two digits are not a valid district number.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Student Number Identifier, Florida and resubmit the records.

- 4. Survey Period Code must be F, W or S and must be correct for the submission specified by the district. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The Survey Period Code as specified in the transmission Job Control Language (JCL) or in statements for tape transmission is identified as Survey Period "W". However, records on the transmission have a Survey Period Code "F". All update, adds or deletes with this inconsistency would be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The Survey Period Code must be corrected either on the records coming in or the transmission JCL and all records must be resubmitted.

- 5. Fiscal Year must be correct for the submission specified by the district. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The Fiscal Year as specified in the transmission JCL or in statements for tape transmission is identified as "0001". However, records on the transmission have Fiscal Year coded as "0102". All updates, adds or deletes with this inconsistency will be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the Fiscal Year either on the records coming in or the transmission JCL and resubmit all records.

6. The Transaction Code must be A, C or D. For the original transmission, only A is valid. For subsequent batch/update submissions, if A is specified then the record must not already exist on the data base; if C or D is specified then the record must exist on the data base. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

For all original transmissions, the Transaction Code must be "A". An original transaction is the first submission of a record during a survey period. After original transmission of records, changes to the record for elements other than the key elements must be done with a "C" as the transaction code. To delete a record, the Transaction Code must be a "D". To change key elements in a batch transaction, the record must FIRST be deleted with a "D" and then added with an "A". Records with an incorrect Transaction Code would be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Transaction Code and resubmit the records.

7. **School Number, Current Instruction/Service must be numeric in the range of 0001 to 9899. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The third record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first and second records would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service is not within the specified range or is not numeric.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Current Instruction/Service and resubmit the records.

8. District Number, Current Instruction/Service must be numeric in the range 01-70 or 72-76 and must be correct for the district submitting the data. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

If District 01 is submitting records, District Number, Current Instruction/Service must be 01 for all records. In the records listed below, the first record would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected since the District Number, Current Instruction/Service is 02 rather than 01 (the number of the District submitting the record).

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the District Number, Current Instruction/Service and resubmit the record.

9. Section Number must not be all blanks. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The second record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first record would be rejected because the Section Number contains all blanks.

12. Grade Level must be 09-12, 30 or 31. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first, fifth and sixth records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The second, third and fourth records would be rejected because Grade Level is invalid.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Grade Level and resubmit the records.

13. The Date of Entry must be numeric and a valid date in the format MMDDYYYY, where MM is a valid month (01-12), DD is a valid day (01-31), and YYYY is a valid year (1981-2002). -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first and second records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third and fourth records would be rejected because the Date of Entry is in the wrong format.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Date of Entry and resubmit the records.

14. The Withdrawal Code, Adult must be in the range W29-W51. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Withdrawal Code, Adult is not valid.

15. The code for Adult Educational Functioning Level, Initial must be either B, C, D, E, F, H, J, N, P, Z, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Adult Educational Functioning Level, Initial code is not valid.

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education, Disability, Student code is not valid.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

19. **Date of Entry must be a date less than the current date. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

Assuming that the records below were submitted for the Fall reporting period in 2000, the first and second records would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Date of Entry is not less than the current date.

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education (AGE) Program Code is not valid.

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Adult Educational Functioning Level, Final is not valid.

25. Course Number must not contain blanks and must be a valid Course Number on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730) unless the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code equals 9900010.
-record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third and fourth records would be rejected because in each case the Course Number is not a valid number on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file.

26. The Course Number must be valid for the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code submitted. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third and fourth records would be rejected because in each case the Vocational/Adult General Education (AGE) Program Code is not valid for the course submitted.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

29. Each record must be unique based on Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Course Number; Section Number and Term. -First record accepted, all other duplicate records rejected-

EXAMPLE

The fifth and eighth records listed below would be rejected because the key items (Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Course Number; Section Number and Term) duplicate the key items in a previous record. The first of two records with the same key information will be loaded to the data base file, assuming it meets all other applicable criteria. Any subsequent records submitted with duplicate data in all the key items would be rejected.

If the records that were accepted and loaded to the data base are the correct ones, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must delete any invalid records, correct any rejected records, if necessary, and resubmit the corrected records.

30. School Number, Current Instruction/Service must exist as a valid number in the District Number, Current Instruction/Service on the Master School Identification File. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The fourth and fifth records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The first, second and third records would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not exist on the Master School Identification file.
