Definition/Domain							
<p>A code indicating whether or not the incident was bullying-related.</p> <table border="0"> <thead> <tr> <th align="left"><u>CODE</u></th> <th align="left"><u>DEFINITION</u></th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td align="center">Y</td> <td>Yes, the incident was bullying-related.</td> </tr> <tr> <td align="center">N</td> <td>No, the incident was not bullying-related.</td> </tr> </tbody> </table> <p>NOTE: The incident is bullying-related if the incident includes unwanted and repeated written, verbal, or physical behavior, including any threatening, insulting, or dehumanizing gesture, by an adult or student that is severe or pervasive enough to create an intimidating, hostile, or offensive educational environment, cause discomfort, or humiliation, or unreasonably interfere with the individual's school performance or participation.</p> <p>If a student or other systematically and chronically inflicted physical hurt or psychological distress on one or more students which may have involved teasing, social exclusion, threat, intimidation, stalking, physical violence, theft, sexual or racial harassment, public humiliation, or destruction of property, then the incident should be reported as bullying related.</p> <p>One of the following SESIR Incident, Type Codes must be reported if Bullying-Related is marked "Y": Arson, Battery, Breaking and Entering, Bullying/Harassment, Disruption on Campus: Major, Fighting, Homicide, Kidnapping, Larceny/Theft, Robbery, Sexual Battery, Sexual Harassment, Sexual Offenses, Threat/Intimidation, Vandalism, Weapons Possession, or Other Major.</p>		<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>	Y	Yes, the incident was bullying-related.
