	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Beginning with the 1998-99 school year, students entering or attending kindergarten are required to show proof of completing the hepatitis B vaccination series which is a three dose series.</li> <li>• Beginning with the 2001-02 school year, students entering or attending preschool or kindergarten are required to show proof of completion of varicella vaccination or documentation of varicella disease.</li> <li>• Beginning with the 2001-02 school year, students entering or attending public preschool are required to show proof of completing the hepatitis B vaccination series which is a three dose series.</li> <li>• Beginning with the 1997-98 School Year, immunizations required for students who enter or attend the 7th grade are; tetanus diphtheria booster, hepatitis B vaccine series, and second dose of measles vaccine.</li> <li>• In the 2007-08 School Year, the only additional immunization required for students who meet Kindergarten immunization requirements and enter or attend the 7<sup>th</sup> grade is the tetanus diphtheria booster.</li> <li>• Beginning with the 2008-09 School Year, students are required to have two doses of varicella vaccine for Kindergarten and each subsequent year thereafter.</li> <li>• Beginning with the 2009-10 School Year, the only additional immunization required for students who meet Kindergarten immunization requirements and enter or attend 7th grade is one tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccination.</li> <li>• Physician's note or laboratory evidence must be verified by the school health nurse.</li> </ul> <p><b>Obsolete Immunization Status codes are listed below.</b></p> <p>Beginning in the 1993-94 school year, codes 5, 6, and 7 are not valid Immunization Status codes for any new student entering Florida schools.
