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<b>Element Name:</b> Incident, Hate Crime-Related									
<b>Definition/Domain</b>									
<p>A code indicating whether or not the incident was hate crime related.</p> <table border="0"> <thead> <tr> <th align="center"><u>CODE</u></th> <th align="center"><u>DEFINITION</u></th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td align="center">Y</td> <td>Yes</td> </tr> <tr> <td align="center">N</td> <td>No</td> </tr> <tr> <td align="center">➔ Z</td> <td>Use this code for (UBL) Unsubstantiated Bullying and (UHR) Unsubstantiated Harassment.</td> </tr> </tbody> </table> <p>Examples: Student spray paints anti-gay slogans on bathroom walls, sends racial slurs to someone in a note or through electronic mail, or uses derogatory language involving someone's religious beliefs in a fight with someone.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> An act, or attempted act, to cause physical injury, emotional suffering or property damage through intimidation, harassment, racial/ethnic slurs and bigoted epithets, vandalism, force or the threat of force, motivated all or in part by hostility to the victim's real or perceived race, religion, color, sexual orientation, ethnicity, ancestry, national origin, political beliefs, marital status, age, social and family background, linguistic preference or mental/physical<sub>1</sub> disability. Creates an intimidating, hostile or offensive educational environment.
