B	Participant has been unemployed for 27 or more weeks at the time of entry.
C	Participant who identifies as low income at program entry. Low Income includes any participants meeting one of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Participant or a member of the immediate family receive benefits through SNAP/TANF, SSI, or other state public assistance 2. Total Family income does not exceed the higher of the poverty line or 70% of the lower living standard income level 3. Is currently in a foster program 4. Has a disability and has a personal income that is at or below the poverty line, regardless of family income 5. Is a youth living in a high-poverty area
