EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

During the 2025 Legislative Session, section 1002.20, Florida Statutes, was amended by Senate Bill 1514, Anaphylaxis in Public and Charter Schools. The statute requires public schools serving K-8 students to provide anaphylaxis training and maintain effective emergency plans for allergic reactions. The purpose of the rule amendments is to reflect the updates.

The proposed rule identifies training that can be used by school districts and charter schools to respond to allergic reactions, identifies necessary elements of training to respond to allergic reactions and lists factors that boards must use to identify personnel for training in the identification response to allergic reactions. Additionally, the rule identifies the elements of plans required to manage severe allergic reactions of students.
