This requirement applies even if the student has received a special diploma, or a GED. Additionally, districts may choose to continue to offer FAPE through the school year in which students turn 22.

Diploma awarded to students who have been properly identified as intellectually disabled, deaf or hard-of-hearing, specific learning disabled, emotional/behavioral disabled, orthopedically impaired, dual sensory impaired, other health impaired, traumatic brain injury, autism spectrum disorder, or language impaired. Effective with the 1994-95 school year, school boards may award Special Diplomas based on two (2) options :

Standard Diploma awarded to students who graduated from school and met all of the requirements to receive a standard diploma based on the Academically Challenging Curriculum to enhance Learning (ACCEL) options, F.S. 1002.3105(5) and satisfied the state graduation test requirement through an approved state concordant and/or comparative score. (WXT)

Standard diploma awarded to students who graduated from school and met all of the requirements to receive a standard diploma based on the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Pathway option, F.S. 1003.4282(11) and satisfied the state graduation test through an approved state concordant and/or comparative score. (WWT)

Standard diploma awarded to any English Language Learner student who has been enrolled in an ESOL program for less than two years who graduated from school with a standard diploma and a formative assessment in lieu of the Statewide Standardized Assessment, per Senate Bill 1108 (2021). (WEL)

Standard diploma awarded to students with disabilities who have received an FCAT waiver, successfully

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completed the minimum number of academic credits as identified in Section 1003.4282, F.S., and achieved a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.(Valid for students who entered 9th grade prior to the 2013-14 school year). (WFW)

(WFT)

Standard Diploma awarded to students who graduated from school and met all of the requirements to receive a standard diploma based on the Academically Challenging Curriculum to enhance Learning (ACCEL) options, F.S. 1002.3105(5) and satisfied the state graduation test requirement through an approved state concordant and/or comparative score. (WXT)

Standard diploma awarded to students who graduated from school and met all of the requirements to receive a standard diploma based on the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Pathway option, F.S. 1003.4282(11) and satisfied the state graduation test through an approved state concordant and/or comparative score. (WWT)

*Note: Florida Department of Education approved standardized test for which scores that are concordant and/or comparative with the passing scores on the state approved graduation test may be used to satisfy graduation requirements for a standard diploma, (Section 1008.22(7)-(8), F.S.).

Standard Diploma:

Standard diploma awarded to any English Language Learner student who has been enrolled in an ESOL program for less than two years who graduated from school with a standard diploma and a formative assessment in lieu of the Statewide Standardized Assessment, per Senate Bill 1108 (2021). (WEL)

Standard diploma awarded to students with disabilities who have received an FCAT waiver, successfully
