STUDENT ASSESSMENT

REJECT RULES

UPDATED 09/12/2025

32.

- If Test Name is IBP then Test Level must be HL or SL.

Note: You may enter HL or SL for IBP.

- If Test Name IBP and Test Subject Content Code is PT then Test Level must be ZZ.

Record rejected

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Test Level is not valid for the Test Name reported.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Test Level or Test Name code and resubmit the record.

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC

REJECT RULES

UPDATED 07/01/2025

If Grade Level = 12, Additional School Year Student code must be D, S, ~~F~~ or Z. If Grade Level is not 12, then Additional School Year Student must be Z. (This edit does not apply to Survey Period 6.)

Record Rejected

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Grade Level is 08 and the Additional School Year Student code is not Z. The third record would be rejected because Grade Level is 12 and Additional School Year Student code is blank.

Florida Education Identifier	Grade Level	Additional School Year Student
FL123456789100	12	S
* FL123456789200	08	S
* FL123456789300	12	

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the database, the district must correct either the Grade Level or the Additional School Year Student code and resubmit the records.

STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION

REJECT RULES

UPDATED 07/01/25

If School Year-Course Taken = School Year-Record Submission, then Course, State Subject Area Requirements must equal A1, AG, AH, BI, CT, EC, EL, EN, EQ, FE, FL, GE, MA, NC, PE, PF, PL, or WH.

Record rejected

EXAMPLE

In the example below, records number two, five, six, and seven would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause the records to be rejected. Records one, three and four would be rejected since the Course, State Subject Area Requirements codes are invalid.

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Course, State Subject Area Requirements and resubmit the records.

If School Year-Course Taken = School Year-Record Submission, then Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements must equal A1, AG, AH, BI, CT, EC, EL, EN, EQ, FE, FL, GE, MA, NC, PE, PF, PL, or WH, or blank. If Course Number, Substituted is blank, Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements must be blank. If Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements is blank, then Course Number, Substituted must be blank.

Record rejected

EXAMPLE

In the example below, the first record would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause it to be rejected. The second record would be rejected since the Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements code is invalid.

Course Number	Course Number Substituted	Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements
0800300	1802300	PE
* 0800300	1802300	PP

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Course Substituted, State Subject Area Requirements code and resubmit the record.

PRIOR SCHOOL STATUS/STUDENT ATTENDANCE

If Withdrawal Code, PK-12 is W06, ~~W08, W8A, W8B~~, W10, WAG, WCO, WD1, WD2, WD3, WEL, WFT, WRW, WWE, WWT, WWW, ~~WGA~~, WGD, WGT, WME, WOC, WXL, WXT, WXW, WD1, or WPC ~~or WPO~~; then Grade Level must be 9-12.

Record rejected

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because Grade Level is not equal to 9-12 and Withdrawal Code, PK-12 is ~~W8A~~W06.

Florida Education Identifier	Grade Level	Withdrawal Code, PK-12
FL123456789100	10	W06
*FL123456789200	08	W8A <u>W06</u>

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct either the Withdrawal Code, PK-12 or Grade Level and resubmit the record.
